What is the meaning of Liturgy of the Pre-Sanctified Gifts?

Liturgy of the Pre-Sanctified Gifts, aka Liturgy of St. Gregory the Great, is a liturgy celebrated during the Great Fast, in which we do not celebrate the Divine Liturgy on weekdays, because each Divine Liturgy is the celebration of Resurrection, of joy and victory of Jesus Christ. This is something we celebrate every Sunday. However, Great Fast is a time of repentance and calling to mind of Christ's passion and death for our sins. Therefore, it is not appropriate to celebrate the Liturgy of Resurrection (Divine Liturgy) during the Great Fast. However, we need God's nourishment to feed our hungry souls. For this reason, the celebrating of the Liturgy of the Pre-Sanctified Gifts was established to accomplish this task. This service does not have Consecration of the Body and Blood. Priest preserves the Holy Communion from the previous Sunday on the altar to be distributed on Wednesday and Friday during the Liturgy of the Pre-Sanctified Gifts. Hence the name, the Gifts we pre-sanctified for the faithful to receive to be sanctified by them.
