

(How Does God Reveal His Law con't)

As outlined so beautifully in the first chapter of Jt. John's Gospel, the Church has always proclaimed the divinity of Jesus Christ. The doctrine of the Blessed Trinity—on God in three Persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit—is the central mystery of the Christian Faith. The Son, Jesus Christ, and the Father are one. Through the Person of Jesus Christ, God redeemed his people and revealed the fullness of moral law, which is handed down to us through the Magisterium of the Catholic Church.

The purpose of human existence is to be united to God the Father, through his Son, Jesus Christ, by the power of the Holy Spirit. It is Jesus Christ, God the Son who became man, who teaches us about the Father and shows us the way that will bring us to him. Through his death and resurrection, he justifies us. In Baptism, we die to sin and are united to Christ, striving to conform ourselves to his example.

By the grace of the Holy Spirit, we are united to Christ and let to the Father. The Holy Spirit sanctifies us and dwells within us, so that we become Temples of the Holy Spirit. Through the Holy Spirit, we are renewed, enlightened, and strengthened to follow the will of God. In this way, the mystery of the Blessed Trinity is at the very heart of our Christian Faith.

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and of Christian life. God alone can make it known to us by revealing himself as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. (CCC 261)
