shall be liable to the hell of fire. (Mt 5: 20-22)

As illustrated in this example, Christ did not change the Fifth Commandment, "Thou shall not kill," but rather elevated it to reflect the plan for human relationships that God had originally intended in creation.

The teachings of Christ are transmitted by the Church in Sacred Tradition and Sacred Scripture and can be found in the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*. The Sermon on the Mount, in which Christ perfected the teachings of the Old Law, relates the primary teachings of Christ on the moral life. The Beatitudes show us the way to perfection.


The teachings of Christ can be summed up as a "law of love"- love of God and love of neighbor. While these teachings were already contained in the Old Law, Christ perfected them, radically redefining the meaning of "neighbor." Christ showed us that our neighbor includes everyone, even those the Old Law allowed us to hate. With the heart of Christ, we are to love everyone as ourselves, for it is only when our hearts are one with Christ that we can conform our will to God's will.

Think not that I have come to abolish the law and the prophets; I have come not to abolish them but to fulfill them. (Mt. 5:17)

The truths revealed by God to his people in the Old Testament were given in order to set the stage for the truth that would be fully revealed by Christ in the New Testament.
